Further inland, you might see an alligator or two lining the Creole Nature Trail, so be on the lookout as you explore nearby wildlife refuges complete with driving and walking trails. If you're the competitive type, be sure to tee off at one of the area's <u>golf courses</u> , including the <u>Contraband Bayou Golf Club</u> at L'Auberge, designed by world renowned golf architect Tom Fazio and the <u>Country Club at Golden Nugget</u> , home of the PGA Korn Ferry Lake Charles Championship.

The popular Downtown at Sundown concert series and the Live at the Lakefront concert series are back-to-back and give the community a chance to come together to support local musicians, artists and vendors. Chuck Fest is another annual celebration that highlights the best in culinary, music and art, while Smoke & Barrel brings out the barbecue side of life along with music on the lawn of the historic courthouse. Rounding out the year, shopping and holiday events pack the calendar from Light Up the Lake to Christmas Under the Oaks . Of course, Mardi Gras is super-
