Dauphine Orleans Hotel

Records of the Dauphine Orleans' site date from 1775, and several of the original structures have survived the test of time. One of our most notable jewels is what is now known as our Audubon Cottage where, from 1821-22, John James Audubon painted his famous "Birds of America" series. The restored cottage now serves as our hotel's main meeting room.

The Dauphine Orleans Hotel is a non-smoking hotel located in the heart of the French Quarter, just one block from the bustle of Bourbon Street and two blocks from the antique stores and art galleries of Royal Street. Our French Quarter boutique hotel features a saltwater pool and 111 guest rooms and suites. Fourteen spacious Hermann House Cottage Guest Rooms and Suites, located across the street from the hotel's main building, were originally built in 1834 to serve as the town home of a prosperous merchant, Samuel Hermann. Each room features a Jacuzzi-style tub.

Our main building features three floors of exquisitely decorated rooms, some with balconies overlooking the courtyard or French Quarter. The Carriage House Guest Rooms and Suites overlook or surround the lush courtyard of the Carriage House, once part of the French Quarter town home. Eighteenth Century architecture and period antiques combine to give these rooms an Old New Orleans feeling without sacrificing modern amenities and services.
